## Aim

- The aim of this programme is to respond to the increased need for trained and registered psychological counsellors in South Africa with a particular focus upon the psychological challenges presented in the arenas of family life and the pastorate.

## Admission Requirements

- A three year bachelor's degree (or equivalent) with psychology as a major subject
- Minimum of 60% average in bachelor's level psychology
- Prerequisite of previous studies for electives.

## Time Commitment

- 2 nights per week over a minimum of two years plus personal study
- Monday and Thursday nights, 18h00-21h30
- 2010 classes commence 1 February

## Cost

- R200 per credit
- Approximate 2010 cost: R14 000 (70 credits)
