Aim

- The Certificate in Christian Ministry provides Christians with a foundational, practical theological training to equip and empower them to build God's Kingdom in their sphere of influence.

Admission Requirements

- A National Senior Certificate with a minimum of 50% in four subjects from the designated subject list (minimum 27 points)
- Grade 12 pass with university exemption or equivalent
- Grade 12 pass with conditional exemption on the grounds of mature age (22 years and older)
- 30 years and over with grade 10 pass
- 40 years and over without any school certificate

Time Commitment

- **For Credit Purposes**

GAP Year: Monday to Friday, 08h30-13h30
OR

- **Evening Class:** Mondays and Thursdays, 18h00 - 21h00, 2 year cycle, commence 14 February and 12 July

- **For Non-Credit Purposes**

Day or evening class: No course work or exams required. Half the cost.
